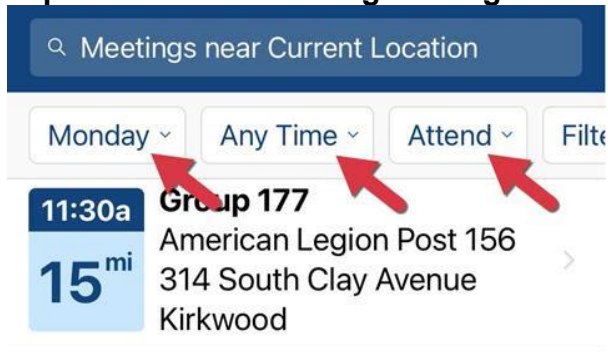
Meeting Guide App Update

Major Release - 4.0

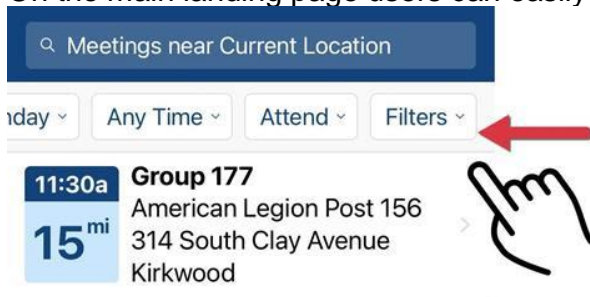
Version 4.0 of Meeting Guide was released on September 6. This release includes the following:

Improvements to meeting filtering



Support for multiple filter selection

On the main landing page users can easily tap to change day, time or attend options.



Users can swipe left on the filter bar to access the All Filters panel. This option allows users to select multiple criteria to narrow meeting results.

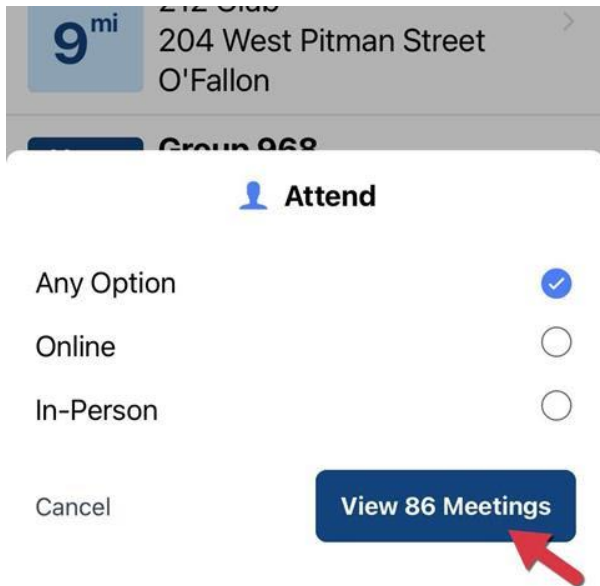
Types are now grouped into different categories making it easier to choose relevant options.

Tapping any of the categories will expand them to display available options. The options are based on the types that are applied to meetings by participating entities.

The View button updates with the number of meetings that match the selected criteria. It is recommended to choose Any Day from the Days option to see the maximum results for specific options.

Retrieval of additional meetings when users select in-person or online attendance options.



When searching for a meeting, the app determines the center point of the user's geolocation and displays the 500 closest meetings within 40 miles.

In this release when members choose to see only online or in-person meetings, Meeting Guide will retrieve a new set of 500 meetings that match the option selected.
